1 Samuel 25

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. In this week’s Scripture passage, we see that David nearly respond to a major slight from Nabal with a kneejerk violent response that might have led to his own death had Abigail not intervened. What usually prevents you from acting on your first impulse when someone offends you?
2. Were you familiar with the story of Nabal, Abigail, and David already? Why do you think a story like this gets fewer sermons preached about it than say, David and Goliath? What’s your takeaway from this story?
3. Has God ever placed an “Abigail” in your life? Someone whose wisdom and kindness changed your life in some way? Did you recognize them at the time or only in looking back on your life?
4. Have you ever had to confront a difficult person? How did it go? What did you learn from that experience?
5. As Christians, what do you think should look different from others regarding how we handle the difficult people we encounter in our lives? How can knowing God help in these kinds of relationships?

PRAYER

Pray for any specific requests, and then pray for the difficult people in your lives and your relationships with them.

CHALLENGE

Look for opportunities to be an Abigail in someone’s life this week. Where can you take time to extend some unexpected kindness to someone you don’t know?
